


Entering Diagnosis Codes and Procedure Codes in eQsuite

Things to remember when entering a diagnosis code

1. Make sure to enter the diagnosis **without** the decimal point.
(Example: F16.121 should be entered F16121)
2. When you enter the DX the “Date Identified” will pre-populate with the start date of services you do not have to change this date, leave as is.
3. If you receive an error that a more detailed code is required you can reference the below website to assist with finding the updated diagnosis codes.

NOTE: AHCA claims are only receiving ICD 10 codes with the additional digits all other claims will not process. It does not matter if the claim being submitted is prior to the implementation date for the requirement of the additional digits. You will need to submit your request with the additional digits.

Procedure/CPT Code Reminders

- Whatever Service type you select on the start tab will determine what type of Procedure/CPT codes you will be able to enter.
(Example: If you select “Outpatient Diagnostic Imaging” as the service you will only be able to enter Diagnostic Imaging CPT Codes)
- Reminder for Inpatient Services you can only enter PCS codes. These are the codes the Hospital uses. You **cannot** use CPT codes for Inpatient services. Please see our How to guide for resources on how to find these codes.
